say that:


1. I presently serve in the South African Navy Reserve as a Rear Admiral.
2. I submitted a statement to the Commission in August 2013 and I testified before the Commission on 20 August 2013. I am still fulfilling the role to which I referred in paragraph 4 of my August 2013 statement.
3. In a letter dated 15 September 2014 from the Commission it was stated that the Chairperson of the Commission required the Department of Defence to provide details of the projected numbers of days it was anticipated the frigates and the submarines would spend at sea.
4. This evidence will supplement the evidence of Rear Admiral Philip Schoultz presented to the Commission over the period of 23 August 2013 and 26 August 2013.
5. I requested that the relevant information be provided to me. The SA Navy's records reflect the planned hours at sea, rather than days at sea as presented by Rear Admiral Philip Schoultz. The following tables set out the relevant information in regard to the frigates and submarines. I also include the actual hours at sea. The information is given for each financial year (FY):
