RESPONSE TO THE QUESTIONS FROM BEELD:

16 JANUARY 2013

1. The Commission has only one agenda, namely, investigating the matters set out in the Terms of Reference forming part of our mandate. Any other agenda that Mr Moabi maybe alleging is a figment of his imagination.
2. The Commission's staff including Mr Moabi, have been engaged in various aspects of the same agenda referred to above and we do not know what Mr Moabi is talking about.
3. In the absence of any indications as to who made the alleged statement and the context in which it was made, we are unable to respond thereto or to your question.
4. Very much so. As a matter of fact, the Commission is busy with preparations for the public hearings to start in March 2013 and we can assure South African public that all the relevant information in our possession will be fully disclosed and interrogated in such public hearings. All the witnesses that will appear before the Commission will be given full latitude to put the information they have relating to any wrong doing in the Arms Procurement Process in the public domain. Nothing will be hidden from the public.
